Open House Public Information Meeting for the Markham/Harvey Stormwater Management Feasibility Study

Markham City Hall, Council Chambers, 16313 S Kedzie Parkway, Markham, IL 60428

Purpose:

Cook County, through CDBG-Disaster Recovery funding provided by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, is conducting a study of flooding within and around the area bounded by 156th Street on the north, 167th Street on the south, I-294 on the west, and Park Avenue on the east. The study seeks to identify feasible alternatives to reduce the frequency and severity of flooding in and around the study area. Input from the community will provide insight into the types of flooding experienced and a more accurate account of the resulting damages.

Background/Additional Information:

The residential areas within and around the study area experienced significant flooding during the April 2013 storm event and resulted in 576 FEMA claims. A secondary purpose of the study is to assess the stormwater management needs associated with the proposed Markham development site (a subarea of the above geography) to explore how these needs might be met off-site, thereby leaving a larger footprint for an industrial development that could create jobs in the area.
